The Belgian Friendship Building, a world icon, on the campus of Virginia Union University is the relocated Belgian Pavilion of the 1939 New York World's Fair. The building was awarded to Virginia Union University from the government of Belgium at the close of the Fair in 1941 because of its mission and location. Its majestic 161 foot tower has been without its bells for more than 60 years. The originals ring from Hoover Tower at Stanford University.
